## Improvements:

- Linda Connors asked for any suggestions on cleaning around the RL historic sign.
- She asked if anyone else was offended by having two utility poles next to each other throughout the Village. For her to have the old pole next to the new pole removed by her house, she had to reach out to cable, telephone and electric companies on a consistent basis - finally the old one was removed.
- The Village crew delivered the topsoil to the north side of the auditorium. Linda raked the soil and planted hostas and grass seed. She was told that the area looks great.
- She made a request if anyone was interested in joining her to realize new projects in the Village.

Festivals: Dick Theissen said the Festival will be Saturday and Sunday; beautiful weather; people happy; parking corded off; everything going along nicely; enjoy yourselves.
